

Identifying Misuse and Abuse: Opioid Management



In 2017, more than 70,000 people died from drug overdoses, with 68% of those involving a prescription or illicit opioid. On average, 130 Americans die every day from an opioid overdose.

Use Case: The ability to access a patient's up-to-date medication history is not only critical to the treatment rendered, it can also be helpful in supporting the identification of potential misuse and abuse of medications impacting this national epidemic.

Project Details

- Provide immediate and expanded electronic access to community medical history data to assist with identifying compliance issues and early detection for identifying potential drug seeking behaviors.
